Until you determine the value of a given thing, you don't know how to treat it.

How does God determine your worth to Him?

Most of us fear the evaluation or judgment of God.

Is God's relationship on us based upon His judgment?

- Yes Sin had to be judged
- No Jesus bore my judgment

<u>James 1:5</u> - If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. *NIV*

- Has your heart been established in the truth that God is not on a fault finding mission toward you?
- Wherever you find your dignity and worth will ultimately become your Lord.
- God has put the desire for value, dignity, esteem, and worth into the heart of mankind.
- The need to have value, esteem, dignity, and worth are at the basis all human behavior.
- If you don't have it, you will do anything to get it.
- We are created by God to seek pleasure and avoid pain.

As long as you believe that serving God is painful and sin is pleasurable, you will never serve God.

<u>Psalm 8:3-6</u> – ³ When I look up into the night skies and see the work of your fingers-the moon and the stars you have made ⁴ what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for and visit him? ⁵ You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings (*elohiym*) and crowned him with glory and honor and dignity and worth. ⁶ You made him to have dominion over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet:

<u>Isaiah 40:12</u> – He measures the heavens with the span of his hands.

When I consider the heavens, what is man?

God crowned us with **glory**, **honor**, **dignity**, **and worth** in the beginning.

<u>Genesis 2:25</u> - And **Adam and Eve were both naked**, the man and his wife, **and were not ashamed.**

What were they clothed with?

<u>Genesis 3:6-10</u> – ⁶ So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. ⁷ Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and **they knew that they were naked**; and they sewed fig leaves together and **made themselves coverings**. ⁸ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife **hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God** among the trees of the garden. ⁹ Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?" ¹⁰ So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid **myself**."

Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

<u>John 17:20-24</u> – ²⁰ I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; ²¹ that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. ²² And **the glory (magnificence, excellence, preeminence, dignity, worth and grace)** which **You gave Me I have given them**, that they may be one just as We are one: ²³ I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and **have loved them as You have loved Me**.
