God is the righteous judge.

**II Timothy 4:7-8** – <sup>7</sup> I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: <sup>8</sup> In the future there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

**Psalm 96:10** – <sup>10</sup> God shall judge the people righteously

**Genesis 18:25** – <sup>25</sup> Shall not the judge of all the earth do right?

In His righteousness, God judged us as guilty and then, in His mercy, took our place.

Jesus is your advocate.

**I John 2:1** – <sup>1</sup> My little children, these things write I unto you that you may not continue in sin. And if any man does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous or yet if anyone does sin, we that have sinned, have counsel for defense in the father's presence, Jesus Christ the righteous.

An advocate is one who represents another.

Be glad that it is Jesus that represents you before the Father and not your sins and failures.

Are you esteeming your sins more highly than the price Jesus paid to represent you before the Father?

**Hebrews 7:25** – <sup>25</sup> Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save everyone who comes to God through him. He lives forever to plead with God on their behalf.

Satan is the prosecuting attorney.

**Revelation 12:10-11** – <sup>10</sup> And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, now is come salvation and strength and the kingdom of our God and the power of his Christ. For the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. <sup>11</sup> And they overcame him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony.

How is truth is determined in heaven's courtroom?

**John 8:13-18,44** – <sup>13</sup> The Pharisees challenged him, "Here you are, appearing as your own witness; your testimony is not valid." <sup>14</sup> Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going. <sup>15</sup> You judge by human standards; I pass judgment on no one. <sup>16</sup> But if I do judge, my decisions are right, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent me. <sup>17</sup> In your own Law it is written that the testimony of two men is valid and true. <sup>18</sup> I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent me."

<sup>44</sup> Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and did not abide in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own or alone: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Who are you cooperating with the devil or Jesus?

**Hebrews 10:23** – <sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering, for we can rely on him who gave us the promise.

**Matthew 12:36-37** – <sup>36</sup> But i say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

<sup>37</sup> For by your words you shall be justified or acquitted and by your words or out of your own mouth you shall be condemned.
