

Jesus Is Redeemer – 03/27/11

Redeem – To purchase back from or to ransom

Genesis 3:15 - From now on you and the woman will be enemies, as will your offspring and hers. You will bruise his heel, but he will crush your head or remove your authority.

Isaiah 53:10-11

10 But it was the Lord's good plan to bruise him and fill him with grief. However, when *his soul has been made an offering* for sin, then he shall have a multitude of children, many heirs. He shall live again, and the will of God shall prosper in his hands.

11 And when he sees all that is accomplished by the anguish of his soul, he shall be satisfied; and because of what he has experienced, my righteous Servant shall make many to be counted righteous before God, for he shall bear all their sins.

John the Baptist – Behold the Lamb of God who will bear the sins of the world.

I Corinthians 6:19-20

19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

20 you were *bought at a price*. Therefore honor God with your body and spirit, which *belong to God*.

We have been **REDEEMED TO** and **REDEEMED FROM!**

REDEEMED FROM:

Galatians 3:13-14

13 Christ has *redeemed us from* the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"),

14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Deuteronomy 28:15-68 – Curse of the Law

- Curses in the city, curses in the fields, the curse of barren wombs, curses upon your crops, curses upon the fertility of your cattle and flocks, curses when you come in, curses when you go out.
- Confusion and a failure in everything you do
- Disease among you until you are destroyed from the face of the earth.
- Tuberculosis, fever, infections, boils, tumors, scurvy, and skin conditions and plagues, for none of which will there be a cure.
- Defeated by your enemies.
- Madness, fear, and panic.
- You shall not prosper in anything you do; you will be oppressed and robbed continually, and nothing will save you.
- You will watch as your sons and daughters are taken away as slaves. Your heart will break with longing for them, but you will not be able to help them.
- Every sickness and plague there is, even those not mentioned in this book.

Isaiah 43:1-3

1 But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for *I have redeemed you*; I have called you by your name; *you are Mine*."

2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you.

3 For I am the LORD your God, The Holy One of Israel, *your Savior*;

Psalm 107:2 - Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,

REDEEMED TO:

Revelation 5:9-10

9 And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have *redeemed us to God by Your blood* out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,

10 And have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall *reign on the earth*."

We have been **REDEEMED from** the hand of the enemy and **REDEEMED to** God, in order that we might reign in life.

Romans 5:17 - For if, by the trespass of the one man, *death reigned* through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness *reign in life* through the one man, *Jesus Christ*.

I Peter 2:9-10

9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own purchased, special people, now belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
