## The Prayer of Faith

- The **Prayer of Faith** can only be prayed where the will of God is known!
- Faith does not "initiate action from God," but responds to the "past tense" of redemption.

## The Past Tense of Redemption

**Colossian 1:12-14** - <sup>12</sup> Giving thanks to the Father, who **has qualified** you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. <sup>13</sup> For he **has rescued us** from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, <sup>14</sup> in whom **we have** redemption, the forgiveness of sins. *NIV* 

**Ephesians 1:6-9** – <sup>6</sup> to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He **made us** accepted in the Beloved. <sup>7</sup> In Him **we have** redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace <sup>8</sup> which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, <sup>9</sup> having **made known** to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, **NKJV** 

**Ephesians 2:4-7** - <sup>4</sup> But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in trespasses, made us **alive together with Christ** (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> and **raised us up together**, and made us **sit together** in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup> that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **NKJV** 

Galatians 3:13-14,29 – <sup>13</sup> Christ HAS ALREADY redeemed us FROM THE CURSE OF THE LAW, being made a curse FOR US. For it is written, Cursed is everyone that hangs on a tree. <sup>14</sup> So that THE BLESSING OF ABRAHAM might come on the gentiles, through Jesus Christ. That we might RECEIVE THE PROMISE of the Spirit THROUGH FAITH.

<sup>29</sup> And if you belong to Christ, then are you **ABRAHAM'S SEED** and **THE PROMISED INHERITANCE IS YOURS!** 

The promise has to be received through faith!

Many are waiting for **God to give the promise**, when God is waiting for us to **receive the promise**, through **faith**.

Faith can only be exercised when the will of God is known!

Mark 11:22-24 - <sup>22</sup> "Have faith in God," Jesus answered. <sup>23</sup> "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes [In His Heart] that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

The Prayer of Faith is a **one-time prayer**.

Thanksgiving is the ongoing voice of the **Prayer of Faith**.

Philippians 4:6 - Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God.

LAZARUS – "This sickness will not end in death."

Once Jesus **SAID IT**, it was **DONE**!

John 11:41-44 – <sup>41</sup> So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you HAVE HEARD ME. <sup>42</sup> I know that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me." <sup>43</sup> When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" <sup>44</sup> The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go."
