Galatians 5:1 (NIV) - It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

God loves us as we are, but He loves us too much to leave us where we are. God loves us so much that we emotionally impact Him. When you know that God loves you, you immediately understand how you can impact him emotionally.

There are three ways you emotionally impact God:

1. He is seeking you.

John 4:23 (NKJV) - But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

2. I can grieve God.

Ephesians 4:30 - And don't grieve, don't bring sorrow or don't break the heart of God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.

When we live apart from God, he is grieved, sorrowful and his heart breaks!

How can the God of the universe love me so much that I can singularly impact Him so dramatically? You grieve in direct proportion to how much you love a person.

3. He delights in me and rejoices over me.

Zephaniah 3:17 - For the LORD your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears. He will rejoice over you with singing."
