After Jesus Rose From The Dead, He Now Points To Us:

<u>Mark 16:15-16</u> - ¹⁵ And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶ He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

We are to accomplish this by the power of the Holy Spirit.

John 5:30 – I can't do anything on my own.

Philippians 2:5-8 – ⁵ Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself. ⁶ He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what. ⁷ Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave, became human! ⁸ Having become human, he stayed human. It was an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that: a crucifixion.

Luke 4:18 –"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed [enabled] Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed.

<u>John 16:7</u> – Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient or good for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter [The Holy Spirit] will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

Very Last Words of Jesus:

<u>Acts 1:8-9</u> – ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ⁹ After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.
