If you can't hear the question, you can't get the right answer.

If you can't hear the instruction – you can't follow it.

Hebrews 3:7-8 – ⁷ Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, **if you will hear His voice**, ⁸ **Do not harden your hearts** as in the rebellion, in the day of trial in the wilderness, *NKJV*

- Ignored the faithfulness of God and continued to express a desire to live under bondage instead of choosing to live a life a faith.
- Since the Word of God is the "primary" voice of God in our lives that reveals the general will of God, and the condition of our hearts determines how we hear and receive, we must ensure our hearts are in the proper condition to hear and receive God's Word.

Exodus 14:17 - And I indeed will **harden the hearts** of the Egyptians, and they **shall follow them** *[into the Red Sea].* So I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army, his chariots, and his horsemen. **NKJV**

A "hardened heart" causes us to make very poor decisions.

We spend a fortune keeping our bodies and for ladies "keeping your skin" vital, and often ignore our hearts, which is the well spring of life.

Beautiful skin, a great body, and a hard heart is not a great combination.

<u>Proverbs 4:20</u> - ²⁰ My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. ²¹ Do not let them depart from your eyes; **keep them** in the **midst of your heart**; ²² For they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.

²³ Keep [protect] your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life. **NKJV**

Protect your heart from what?

<u>Hebrews 3:13</u> - but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. *NKJV*

Mark 4:9-13 – 9 And He said to them, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!" 10 But when He was alone, those around Him with the twelve asked Him about the parable. 11 And He said to them, "To you it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables, 12 so that 'Seeing they may see and **not perceive**, and hearing they may hear and **not understand**; lest they should turn, and their sins be forgiven them." 13 And He said to them, "Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?

<u>John 15:7-8</u> - ⁷ If you abide in Me, and if My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. ⁸ By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be my disciples. *NKJV*
