<u>I Corinthians 3:5-9 (GWT)</u> − <sup>5</sup> Who is Apollos? Who is Paul? They are servants who helped you come to faith. Each did what the Lord gave or called him to do. <sup>6</sup> I planted, and Apollos watered, but God made it grow. <sup>7</sup> So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, because only God makes it grow. <sup>8</sup> The one who plants and the one who waters have the same goal, and each will receive a reward for his own work. <sup>9</sup> We are God's coworkers. You are God's field.

We Labor together with God. Without God, I cannot. Without me, God will not. God rewards my obedience to my call. Finding our call, begins with hearing His voice.

<u>Jeremiah 33:3 (NIV)</u> – <sup>3</sup> Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.
