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There are three keys to overcoming injustice.

1. Don't blame god

Don't blame God for the inequity of your past.

Luke 13:16 (NKJV) – ¹⁶ So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?"

John 10:10 (NIV) – ¹⁰ The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

Luke 4:18-19 (MSG) – ¹⁸ God's Spirit is on me; he's chosen me to preach the Message of good news to the poor, Sent me to announce pardon to prisoners and recovery of sight to the blind, To set the burdened and battered free, ¹⁹ to announce, "This is God's year to act!"

2. The great exchange

Our past puts an imprint upon our hearts.

Proverbs 23:7 (NKJV) – ⁷ For as he thinks in his heart, so is he.

Matthew 22:20-21 (NKJV) – ²⁰ And He said to them, "Whose image and inscription is this?" ²¹ They said to Him, "Caesar's." And He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's."

Our Past has struck an "imprint" upon our hearts. A new image, God's image, must be "struck" upon our hearts.

Isaiah 40:29-31 (NKJV) – ²⁹ He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. ³⁰ Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, ³¹ But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew or exchange their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

3. This war stops now

This war stops now or we perpetuate the pain to the next generation. Your freedom or your pain will be imparted to your children.
