#### FEAR

- FEAR is the greatest limiting factor when it comes to doing what God has told you to do.
- Over 300 times in scripture we are told to FEAR NOT.
- FEAR will hold you back from your NEXT STEPS in taking the limits off of God!

  - Harvest depends ENTIRELY
- 3. Extravagant Gifts Projects Rarely celebrated

II Corinthians 9:13 - You will be glorifying God through your generous gifts. NLT

#### Many extravagant gifts in the Bible:

- David gave billions in today's dollars.
- Mary poured perfume valued at year's wage upon Jesus.
- 11 of the 12 apostles were martyred.
- Many have been EXTRAVAGANT to get us here!
- I am persuaded that every Christian will be asked by God to GIVE EXTRAVAGANTLY at different points of their lives.

I Kings 19:4 - Elijah went a day's journey into the desert. He came to a broom tree, sat down under it and prayed that he might die. "I have had enough, LORD," he said. "Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors."

## God tells him to:

- 1. Go anoint Elisha to take your place
  - Prepare the Next Generation
  - The ministry wouldn't die with Elijah
- 2. There are 7,000 who are mine and you are not alone
  - I have prepared people for this purpose, not you.

**Mark 10:28-31** – <sup>28</sup> Peter said to him, "We have left everything to follow you!" <sup>29</sup> "I tell you the truth," Jesus replied, "no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel <sup>30</sup> will fail to receive a hundred fold as much **in this present age** (homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields-and with them, persecutions) and **in the age to come**, eternal life. <sup>31</sup> But many who are first will be last, and the last first." *NIV*
