The Word of God imparted into your daily life is how you grow spiritually, discover direction, and find true freedom.

<u>I Peter 2:2</u> – As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the Word, that you may grow thereby.

Five Steps to Have a Devotional Life:

- 1. Set a time and a daily appointment
- 2. Be still and worship
- 3. Pray
- 4. Read the Word (God speaks through His Word) and listen and write (God speaks to you)

II Timothy 3:16-17 – ¹⁶ Every Scripture is God-breathed (given by His inspiration) and profitable for instruction, for reproof and **conviction of sin**, for **correction of error and discipline in obedience, [and] for training in righteousness** (in holy living, in conformity to God's will in thought, purpose, and action), ¹⁷ and through the Word we are **put together and shaped up** for the tasks God has for us.

Psalm 119:105 – By your words I can see where I'm going; they throw a beam of light on my dark path.

<u>Matthew 4:4</u> – Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' "

Conviction of Sin:

Your final authority on right and wrong must be God's Word.

John 17:14-19 – ¹⁴ I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁵ I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁷ Sanctify or set them apart by Your truth. Your word is truth. ¹⁸ As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. ¹⁹ And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified or set apart by the truth.

Correction of Error and Discipline in Obedience & Training in Righteousness:

Proverbs 14:12 – There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death.

<u>John 15:1-4</u> – "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.³ You are clean [pruned] because of the word which I have spoken to you.⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.
